This weekend we are invited to walk with Jesus and with each other through the liturgies of Holy Week entering more deeply into God's love for each and every one of us. On Palm Sunday we have Jesus' entry into Jerusalem with the crowds waving palms and singing their Hosannas, followed by the solemn reading of the Passion of Our Lord according to Mark. On Holy Thursday the oils, blessed and consecrated by Bishop Marcus in the Cathedral during the Chrism Mass will be brought to the altar when we thank God for the gift of Jesus himself in the Eucharist. On Good Friday we walk to Calvary guided by the Passion Narrative according to John, and we venerate the cross on which Jesus died, but which becomes for us the Tree of Life. The mood on Holy Saturday is one of waiting, meditating on the Lord's death before celebrating his victory over sin and death by being raised by the Father, then our song will be "Alleluia!"
