to resentment, scorn for others or the desire to hurt or gain some advantage. The Christian ideal, especially for families, is a love that never gives up. I am sometimes amazed to see men and women who have had to separate fro their spouse for their own protection, yet, because of their enduring conjugal love, still try to help them, even by enlisting others, int their moment of illness, suffering or trial. Here too, we see love that never gives up.
