Knowing that Jesus was hungry, the tempter appeared to him and said, 'If you are the Son of God, turn these stones into loaves.' But Jesus replied with God's word saying, 'Scripture says: "Man does not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.' Jesus was then faced with two more temptations and both times he replied with God's word and resisted. Then Jesus said, "Be off, Satan!" Then the tempter left him, and angels appeared and looked after him.
