Jesus sais to his disciples: "You have learnt how it was said: you must love your neighbour and hate your enemy. But I say this to you: love your enemies and pray for those who are unkind to you and say bad things about you; in this way you will be sons and daughters of God, your Father in heaven. For God causes his sun to rise on good and bad people, and his rain to fall on honest and dishonest people alike. For if you only love those who you like, why should you be rewarded, even sinners do that! And if you are friendly only to the people you like, are you doing anything exceptional? You must be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect."
