After the longest and fullest Advent we can experience in the Church's Liturgical Year, this weekend we have the great joy of celebrating the Solemnity of Our Lord's Birth at Christmas.

Last Saturday more than a dozen families came together to listen and sing about the birth of Jesus, and then, with

a creativity beyond expectation they created both a Christmas Tree and a crib scene, both of which are in the porch to welcome everyone to celebrate Mass this Christmas. Have a look as you enter and leave the church today.

We will also have opportunities over the Christmas season to look into the crib in front of the altar and to share our own thoughts and prayers with the Lord. As we do so we will be aware that in many parts of the world families will NOT be free to visit a church or other places of worship, but rather will be seeking out somewhere they can go for safety. We ask the Prince of Peace to bring peace into our world.

CRIB OFFERINGS:

This year, at the request of Bishop Marcus, our parish will be donating crib offerings to **Friends of the Holy Land**. Every penny will help the poorest Christian families, especially in and around Bethlehem, the West Bank, Gaza and Israel, with education, employment, health and housing initiatives. Friends of the Holy Land is apolitical and ecumenical.
