Vocations Sunday

Throughout the world-wide Catholic Church we are asked to pray for vocations to the Priesthood and the Religious Life. We are only too aware in our own diocese of Leeds of the age profile of the clergy and of the relatively small number of ordinations in the recent past. This year two men will be ordained to the priesthood in the summer for service in our diocese, but this will not compensate for the

number of priests retiring at the age of 75 and above. This week the Dewsbury Deanery has submitted its final proposals to the Bishop for a reorganisation which will see the number of clergy being reduced from 7 to 3! Please do pray for vocations to the priesthood, the diaconate and the religious life. Pope Francis also reminds us that all of us have a vocation to be true disciples of Christ so that all of us can be 'led by the Spirit for mission'.
