From Sunday's Gospel

Jesus said to his disciples, 'There was once a man who set out on a journey. Before he left, he summoned his servants; to ne he gave five talents (a large amount of money in those days), to another he gave two talents and to a third he gave one talent. After a long time he returned. The servant who had received the five talents had made five more, and the servant who had receive the two talents had made two more. The master was delighted and said to them, "Well done, good and faithful servants; come and share your master's joy." But the servant who had received the one talent had just buried it in the ground and then dug it up and returned it to his master. The master was very angry, told the servant that he should have at least put it in the bank to gain interest, and then had him thrown out.'

talents means for us an ability or a gift. We speak of someone having a talent for music, or we say that someone is very talented at baking. Can we ask ourselves, 'what are my talents and how will I use them this week?'
