#### Modern Day Slavery and Human Trafficking



On Saturday 8th February the Church kept the memory of St Josephine Bakhita, who was enslaved as a child and then regained her freedom. Over the past few years the Catholic Church has brought to our attention the de-humanising impact of Human Trafficking and Modern Slavery in England and Wales. It is estimated that there are 40 million people worldwide who are current victim of Modern Day Slavery, and over 150 million

children who are being exploited in child labour worldwide. In the UK there are around 140,000 people caught up in trafficking and modern day slavery at any one time with displaced people being the most vulnerable.



#### Racial Justice Sunday

"This weekend Sunday 9th February 2020 the Catholic Church in England and Wales will celebrate Racial Justice—the theme is "You are at the heart of the Church." It will celebrate the contribution Travelling Communities make to the
