From Sunday's Gospel

Jesus sent out his friends, the disciples, in pairs to tell the Good News of God. They were not to take anything for the journey except a staff—no bread, no haversack, no coppers for their purses. They were to wear sandals, but Jesus added, 'Do not take a spare tunic.' He told them to stay where they were made welcome. But if people did not listen to their message, they were to shake the dust off their feet as they left that house. So the disciples went out and started telling everyone to change their lives and to turn back to God, and they healed many people who were sick.



Pope Francis writes:

"Open up your hearts and listen to what God is saying to you. The family is where we first learn to listen and share."

Today's word is **Listening**. Listening is a sign of real love, it is a powerful way of showing that we care. Listening to the right people and the right message is important for us and for our children. Jesus doesn't force us to listen to him or to the people whom he continues to send with his message, but if we do we will know what is best for us when we make important decisions.
