Parish Priests have been asked to nominate individuals with expertise in the four recommendation categories: "Community and Outreach," "Leadership and Collaboration," "Spirituality and Formation," and "Young People and Schools," so that we can build a vision and direction, and share best practice, for our future. And for this continuing work, let us pray, "Stay with us, Lord, on our Journey." Bishop John.
