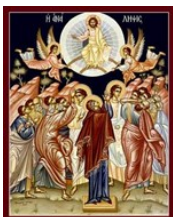

Little Sisters of the Poor

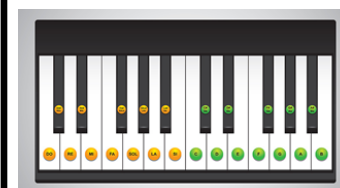
