#### From Sunday's Gospel

Some people were talking about the beautiful stones used to build the Temple and about the gift that had been placed within the Temple. Jesus said, "The time will come when not a single stone will be left on another; they will all be knocked down." The disciples asked Jesu when this would happen and he replied, "Before the world ends, many things will happen. People will appear and pretend to be me by saying, 'I am the Christ and now is the time.' But do not believe them and do not follow them. And when you hear about wars and earthquakes, do not be afraid; just stay faithful to me."



Pope Francis writes, "My dear young people, let us ask then for the grace to remain faithful to God and to listening to his

word." Today's word is Faithfulness. If we choose to be faithful to Jesus we still need God's help and the help of the

Church (the community of the faithful) to stay faithful. A faithful person is a gift to the world. How can we grow in faithfulness to God and to each other?
