#### **Bishop John Wilson**

The Holy See announced on Monday June 10th the appointment of Archbishop-Elect John Wilson as the 11th Archbishop of Southwark. Arch-Bishop Elect Wilson succeeds the Most Reverend Peter Smith, who has been Archbishop of Southwark since 2010. Archbishop-Elect Wilson, Auxiliary Bishop of Westminster since 2015 and previously a priest in the Diocese of

Leeds, will be the 11th Archbishop of Southwark and his Episcopal Installation will be celebrated in St George's Cathedral, Southwark, on 25th July. Speaking of his appointment, Archbishop-Elect Wilson said: "Someone once said if you want to make God laugh tell him your plans. In whatever way I may have imagined God's plan for my life to unfold, the news of my appointment by Pope Francis as the new Archbishop of Southwark came as a complete surprise. I am grateful to his Excellency Archbishop Edward J Adams, the Apostolic Nuncio,

for his encouragement, and for reminding me of C.S.Lews invitation to be 'surprised by joy.' It is the joy of the Gospel, the Good News of God's love for the world in his Son Jesus Christ, that sustains and animates the Church's mission in which I am to share in a new way...Please pray for me as I prepare to begin this new ministry of service as a witness to Jesus Christ."
