When I arrived in the parish, I was told that the pathway was church property, this is not the case, I have at last seen the deeds. The clearing of the small garden plot at the back of the hall, was to have chippings placed onto it, to allow extra drop off space for the shop. This, now, cannot happen, and we must continue with the original agreement made with the landowner, that the two marked parking spots next to the presbytery are to be used, one as a permanent spot for the incumbent priest, and the other may be used for drop off, or visitors to the parish IF and WHEN it is available.
