



Pope Francis writes, "My dear young people, what does it mean to be 'Blessed'? To be blessed means to be happy." Today's word is Saints. In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells us those who know they need God,

the poor in spirit, already have the kingdom of heaven in their lives. This Sunday we celebrate All Saints, those who have gone through the process of canonisation, and those who have modelled their lives on the Beatitudes which we heard about in the Gospel. You can see a slightly different version of the Beatitudes above which might help us to think about them in a fresh way. We might have a favourite saint who we ask to help us in our daily lives. We might have been called after a saint. If so why not ask your parents why they chose this particular saint's name for you? What this feast reminds us is that all of us can try to be saints, all of us are called to be holy, and Jesus in the gospel today gives us a number of ways of being holy by trying to live the Beatitudes.
